If provided with enough stimulation, they do a better job than many parrots at keeping themselves occupied when you're not. Persistence with doing this usually pays off well as you will end up with a very happy and cooperative bird. It is generally difficult to guess the age of parrots.

They can live up to 30 years, so think carefully before adopting one. Even a young bird that has not been neglected and abused requires proper guidance; this becomes even more challenging when it involves a rescued bird that may require rehabilitation. When teaching your eclectus to stand on a perch or elsewhere you can do so by luring them with a treat. Last but not least, your pet will need a variety of perches, all of different strengths and textures.

The wings should be kept trim if you want to discourage flight and to prevent the wings from getting too large. It is important that all babies get a good start in life, both nutritionally and psychologically.
